## 2018 Summer Positions

**Counselor** - Counselors work directly with campers ages 6-14 for the duration of the summer. They are responsible for carrying out the weekly program with campers by being positive role models, living with their campers during the week, and providing support and care for each camper. Applicants must have a sincere desire to work with youth. These individuals shall be at least 18 years of age, one year post high school, and have previous experience working with children.

**Program Specialist** – Several staff take on additional responsibilities to help facilitate the daily implementation of the Camp O' Malley program. They provide the instruction and oversight for various activities offered at camp, including: high ropes course, climbing wall, archery, and lifeguards.

**Maintenance** - Maintenance staff will be responsible for the daily cleaning and maintenance of camp facilities. Prior maintenance experience preferred. Applicant must be at least 18 years of age. This staff member will work approximately 25-35 hours per week. This is not necessarily an overnight position.

**Camp Gardener** - The Camp Gardener is responsible for overseeing and implementing Camp O'Malley's garden program. Duties include preparing, planting, weeding, pruning, watering, harvesting and taking care of all aspects of the garden. Responsible for developing daily programming, teaching campers the educational aspects of gardening.

**Aquatics Coordinator** - The Aquatics Coordinator will work closely with the Program Coordinator in terms of scheduling program specialists on a daily basis. The Aquatics Coordinator is responsible for overseeing all aspects of the aquatics program, including all off-campus aquatic events. This position is also responsible for the upkeep of the pool facility, including daily chemical testing and documentation.  
Must be at least 21 years of age and have prior supervisory experience.

**Staffing Coordinator** - This person serves as a support to staff members and campers. Works closely with campers in need of direction by providing support, guidance and positive behavioral interventions to improve poor behavior. They will help assist with camper discipline and emergency situations. This person serves as a supervisor for counseling staff, providing on-going direction and support. The Staffing Coordinator is also responsible for making staff assignments on a weekly basis.  
Preferably 21 years of age and have prior leadership and camp experience as well as working with youth.

**Junior Staff Coordinator** – The Junior Staff Coordinator is responsible for overseeing the daily activities and routines of the Camp O'Malley Junior Counselors. Junior Counselors are minors between the ages 15 and 17 who help with daily food service prep and clean up as well as custodial responsibilities. They also spend a significant amount of time helping Counselors with their cabin groups. Must be at least 21 years of age and have adequate leadership experience and the ability to mentor and high school youth.
