Summer Camp Staff Positions

Counselors- Counselors work directly with campers ages 6-14 for the duration of the summer. They are responsible for carrying out the weekly program with campers by being positive role models, living with their campers during the week, and providing support and care for each camper.

Must be at least 18 years of age, one year post high school, and have previous experience working with children.

Program Specialists – Several staff take on additional responsibilities to help facilitate the implementation of the Camp O' Malley program by leading specialized activities. They provide the instruction and oversight for various program areas at camp, including: climbing wall, archery, kayaking, and lifeguarding at the pool.

Camp Gardener – The Camp Gardener is responsible for overseeing and implementing the community garden program. Duties include day-to-day care of the garden and developing programming to teach campers about gardening and farming. Prefer two or more years of gardening or farming experience.

Staffing Coordinator – The Staffing Coordinator serves as a support and leader for staff members and campers. This person works with campers in need of direction by providing support, guidance, and positive behavioral interventions. They will assist with camper discipline and emergency situations. Preferably be at least 21 years of age and have adequate leadership experience.

Program Coordinator – The Program Coordinator plans and implements the programs at camp. Working with the camp director and the rest of the leadership team, this individual organizes the schedule and leads many all-camp activities. Must have at least one year of experience at camp or in a similar setting, preferably at least 21 years of age.

Health Officer – The Health Officer is responsible for the health and safety of each camper and staff member at Camp O'Malley. This person maintains all medical records, administers medications, provides a health screening for all campers, and is responsible for the treatment of all participants. Must be at least 20 years of age, preferably with or working on a nursing or medical degree.

Aquatics Coordinator - The Aquatics Coordinator will work closely with the Program Coordinator in terms of scheduling program specialists on a daily basis. The Aquatics Coordinator is responsible for overseeing all aspects of the aquatics program, including all off-campus aquatic events. This position is also responsible for the upkeep of the pool facility, including daily chemical testing and documentation. Must be at least 18 years of age, be Lifeguard certified, and have prior supervisory experience.

Junior Staff Coordinator – The Junior Staff Coordinator is responsible for overseeing the daily activities and routines of the Camp O'Malley's Junior Counselors, who are high school students that help with daily food service prep and clean up as well as custodial responsibilities. Preferably be at least 21 years of age and have adequate leadership experience and the ability to mentor and high school youth.

Maintenance - Maintenance staff are responsible for the daily cleaning and maintenance of camp facilities. This is not necessarily an overnight position. Prior maintenance experience preferred. Applicant must be at least 18 years of age.
